NOTE: Schedule 1 of the List of Wastes (England) Regulations SI 2005/895, essentially reproduces the list of wastes set out in European Waste Catalogue in Decision 2000/532/EC, for the purposes of the Hazardous Waste (England and Wales) Regulations SI 2005/894. This is a list of all waste and their EWC that need to be used on Project Waste Reporting. Although your site will not use all the codes, please find below the list of all categories.
